The major concern for Hardingstone Parish is the Development at The Green, Great Houghton. (Figure 18, page 101).

Being in the proximity of the Hardingstone SUE, Hampton Green, St. George's Fields, and further developments in Wootton, it would add an unsustainable volume of traffic to the already over-capacity A428 Bedford Road and B526 Newport Pagnell Road, as well as all the other roads leading to the A45 and Junction 15 of the M1.

It can only result in total gridlock with associated air pollution.

There is no feasible possibility of mitigation of this problem, to which developers and planners turn a blind eye. The much-used word "sustainability" seems to have little meaning in practice.

Modal Shift:

Walking and cycle routes are very commendable but have limited appeal, especially in foul weather.

Bus service improvements (Appendix D, T12, T25 etc.) would be useful for travellers to the town centre but many residents would be commuters wanting to access the M1.

Recent cuts to services suggest that these improvements may not be sustainable in the long-term.

Also North Gate Bus station is already inadequate for the present number of buses; where would they operate from? Considering the increase in population, sensible bus and coach facilities are essential for a town of this size.
