A total of 840 extra houses for land at The Green over the next 15 years starting with 250 (50 per year) being built in years 1-5 continuing with 100 new homes each year thereafter. This will create approximately 4000 extra vehicle movements through Great Houghton per day.

Paragraph 225

There is no current information regarding the upgrade of the road known as The Green from the southern proposed link to the minor junction on the B526 Newport Pagnell Rd to the new site the exisiting road is in very poor repair and in some places extremely difficult for vehicles to pass.

From the north the A438 Bedford Rd there is no current data on traffic movements within the report and no evidence or data to provide evidence of the impact on Great Houghton the extra vehicle movements will cause.

The Green is a part of the National Cycle network route No. 6 the are no clear plans for safeguarding cyclists from the increased traffic movements apart from the upgrade for foot and cycle movements within the boundary of the development. This upgrade should extend to the full extent of The Green both to the junction of the B526 and to the existing village and right through the village to the A428.

There is an issue with pedestrian safety, there are no footpaths currently and none planned with the exception of the upgraded section within the boundary of the development. Great Houghton and it's surrounding road network are very popular with cyclists and walkers. Yet there is no assessment of safety linked to the additional traffic movement through Great Houghton, nor any traffic measures being considered to reduce or mitigate any increased traffic risks in the village of Great Houghton.

Policy 36 - LAA1098

There is no current information regarding the upgrade of existing infrastructure known as The Green apart from the development of the site for residential homes. Nothing in the documentation considers the impact this will have on local GP surgeries, schools and services which already have waiting lists.

The policy says nothing about improved or increased public transport to and from the site and the document does not address the impact of the inevitable increase in traffic through the existing village of Great Houghton. In particular there is no assessment of air quality or the extent and deterioration of the air quality the significant increase in traffic is likely to cause.

The anticipated increase in vehicle movements will have a dramatic effect on the local residents of Great Houghton, pedestrians, cyclists and the general environment, linked to air quality and safety.
