It would be question of when, not if, the first fatality would occur. There is no room to improve the road.

If you are suggesting that people can bicycle instead I would invite you to cross the busy 60mph Bedford Road at the bottom of the hill in to village and cycle to the top. The only people you see doing that are sports cyclists who like to test their stamina and it can be seen that some of them realise that they have misjudged their ability. Even to tackle it from halfway up is beyond ordinary cyclists capability.

So far as public transport is concerned, there is none to speak of bar a community mini bus valiantly run by the local villages. That can be full before it even reaches the top of Great Houghton and it is not easy for it to pass the parked cars on the road.
