.It is fenced off and not open to the public.

This wildlife area is a haven for birds and animals and contains many species of plants and trees. All of which have been catalogued.

This is a valuable area of natural green space in an urban setting and should not be included in the housing allocation.

On the advice of the Northamptonshire Wildlife Trust the Neighbourhood Forum will be making an application for this to be designated Local Green Space as part of the Neighbourhood Planning process.
