The proposal for 265 houses on land off Watering Lane Collingtree does not make sense in view of the following observations.

- 1. This land lies in an area where air pollution is above the legal limit and pollution from the M1 is blown over it by the prevailing south-westerly wind. The government has indicated it is taking steps to stop development in areas affected by air pollution so this proposal would be likely to fail this test especially re child health.
- 2. The planning inspector who dealt with the proposed Bovis development on a site which is also to the immediate north of the M1 decided that houses should not be situated within 200 metres of the M1. Considerable bunding would be required even to achieve this and houses would not be allowed opening windows. The Watering Lane proposal does not have the depth of land to achieve this in a practical manner.
- 3. If the proposed development of warehousing to the immediate south of the M1 in this area were to be allowed, the proposed housing would face yet further pollution and a terrible quality of life from 24 hour working.
- 4. The land proposed for this housing is currently well farmed agricultural land which is understood to be part of the land-bank the County Council has to retain for leasing to tenant farmers. Concern over the need to provide such land to cut down on transport costs and the effect on the environment is another government policy with which this plan would be in conflict. Use of green space is also being heavily criticised
- 5. Part of this land is occupied by the Collingtree Allotment Association plot which, even if not needed for the development ,would be seriously compromised in terms of continued productive use and would require high fencing to keep it as a secure and worthwhile growing space. The government requires such plots be provided and this helps its policy of keeping folk fitter and well fed to avoid illness and avoid unnecessary stress on the NHS. With rising food prices, poorer pensioners and young families need self grown food to help their budgets.
