Following the events of 1998, fluvial flood defence structures were constructed within the borough to the 1 in 200 year standard. Within the Upper Nene Catchment Local standards for surface water drainage of the same 1 in 200 year standard with an additional allowance for climate change were imposed to protect against pluvial flooding. Nationally, the 1 in 200 year standard is exceptional. We would note that the Upper Nene Catchment 1 in 200 year plus an allowance for climate change which encompasses the majority of the Borough of Northampton is not mentioned anywhere within the document.

We would request that the Upper Nene Catchment standard for surface water drainage is incorporated within paragraphs 93-96

We welcome the inclusion within the Local Plan of the Local Standards and Guidance for Surface Water Drainage in Northamptonshire.

However we note that paragraph 96 states 'The guide is designed to assist developers in the design of a surface water drainage system and to support local planning authorities in considering drainage proposal for new developments'

We would request that the paragraph emphasises the requirement of a surface water drainage system to meet the national and local standards as required of the document.

We would suggest the paragraph states, The guide is designed to assist developers in the design of a surface water drainage system in order to meet the required local standards and to support local planning authorities in considering drainage proposal for new developments'

Policy 6 determines that proposals that do not increase flood risk will be supported. Whilst the aim of the Local Standards is just that, the status quo is the baseline. Developments are required to consider flood risk, mitigate and where possible reduce flood risk. Brownfield sites are required to reduce discharge of surface water from the site by 40%. This betterment is likely to be increased in the near future to a reduction to greenfield run off rates in line with restrictions placed on discharge of surface water sewers by Anglian Water from brownfield sites into Anglian Water owned surface water sewers.

We believe Policy 6 should require that development will not increase flood risk, will, where possible, reduce the risk of flooding and for previously developed land, Brownfield sites, provide a betterment in regards surface water discharge from the development in accordance with local standards.

We note Policy 12. From the list of proposed developments, the majority of the proposed sites will be classified as major development however 10% of development is classified as minor development, being less than 10 dwellings. The accumulative effect of windfall sites of less than 10 dwellings in regards flood risk is not considered within the Local Plan. Sustainable drainage solutions are available for all size of development.

We would request that Policy 6 requires that all development incorporate sustainable drainage systems.

Policy 34, 35, 37 and 38 should make reference to the Upper Nene Catchment standard of 1 in 200 years plus an allowance for climate change for surface water drainage
