The Council's Low Emission Strategy (LES) aims to improve air quality and health across Northampton by reducing vehicle emissions through the accelerated take up of cleaner fuels and technologies (and the implementation of mitigation measures in new developments.) Evidence for the strategy found that whilst levels of nitrogen dioxide have improved in some areas of Northampton, concentrations (of NO2 and particulate matter specifically PM 10's) at key locations have remained elevated over the last decade and at some locations, concentrations have increased, (resulting in declarations of Air Quality Management Areas.)

These are areas which exceed the Government's air quality objective and where there is relevant exposure to the public. (A consultation is presently underway to amalgamate all the central AQMA's into one large AQMA covering the town centre to promote consistency in applying the LES).
