Further to our recent telephone conversation thank you for agreeing a short extension of time for Boughton Parish Council to respond to the above consultation.

Following a meeting of the full Council on Monday evening the Parish Council have requested that I write to you. Councillors are extremely concerned to note that the above site is being considered for further investigation.

This site has previously been considered and explored by NBC and rejected due to the detrimental impact that further traffic movements will have along the Harborough Road and Kingsthorpe corridor and the fact that it is a declared AQMA (Zone 4) in Northampton.

Further pressure on the local highway network including the Cock Hotel junction and the Five Bells junction in Kingsthorpe, which is already at capacity, is absolutely unacceptable. Current development in this area of Northampton is severely impacting on roads and existing infrastructure making the daily commute into Northampton a misery for local residents.

The Parish Council considers that residential development on this site will have a further significant impact on current infrastructure in the local area and any further pressure on the road network and local services should be resisted.

The Parish Council would urge that this site is not appropriate and that it be withdrawn from further consideration due to the reasons above and the adverse impact it will have both on the highway network and the local area.
