What is this information about?

Northampton Borough Council has received an application from *Growing Together*, requesting formal designation as a Neighbourhood Forum for the purposes of preparing a Neighbourhood Plan. In addition, *Growing Together* have submitted an application to designate Blackthorn, Goldings, Lings and Lumbertubs as a Neighbourhood Area – the area to which a Neighbourhood Plan will apply.

Northampton Borough Council is legally required to publicise the receipt of this application and invite comments for a period of six weeks.

This form is provided to help you to submit comments to the consultation on the application received. This form has a map attached which you can use to show any boundary changes you may feel are required.

What should comments relate to?

Comments relating to the proposed Neighbourhood Forum should focus on the appropriateness of the group to prepare a Neighbourhood Plan. If designated, no other organisation or body may prepare a Neighbourhood Plan for the area.

Comments relating to the proposed Neighbourhood Area should consider whether this is a suitable boundary for the Neighbourhood Plan. There may be, for example, buildings or streets that should be included or excluded from the Neighbourhood Area.

In responding to the Area or Forum, you are encouraged to provide reasons. This will help the Borough Council in reaching a decision.

What happens to my comments?

Any comments received will be fully considered by the responsible planning officer. The proposal will be judged against the relevant Council policies and Government advice before a recommendation is made. A detailed summary of all comments received and any resulting changes required will be reported to the Council's Cabinet before decisions are made.

Please note: you do not have to use this form to make representations but it would be helpful if you could. If not please provide the information set out below in your response to ensure we receive all of the information that we require as part of the consultation process.

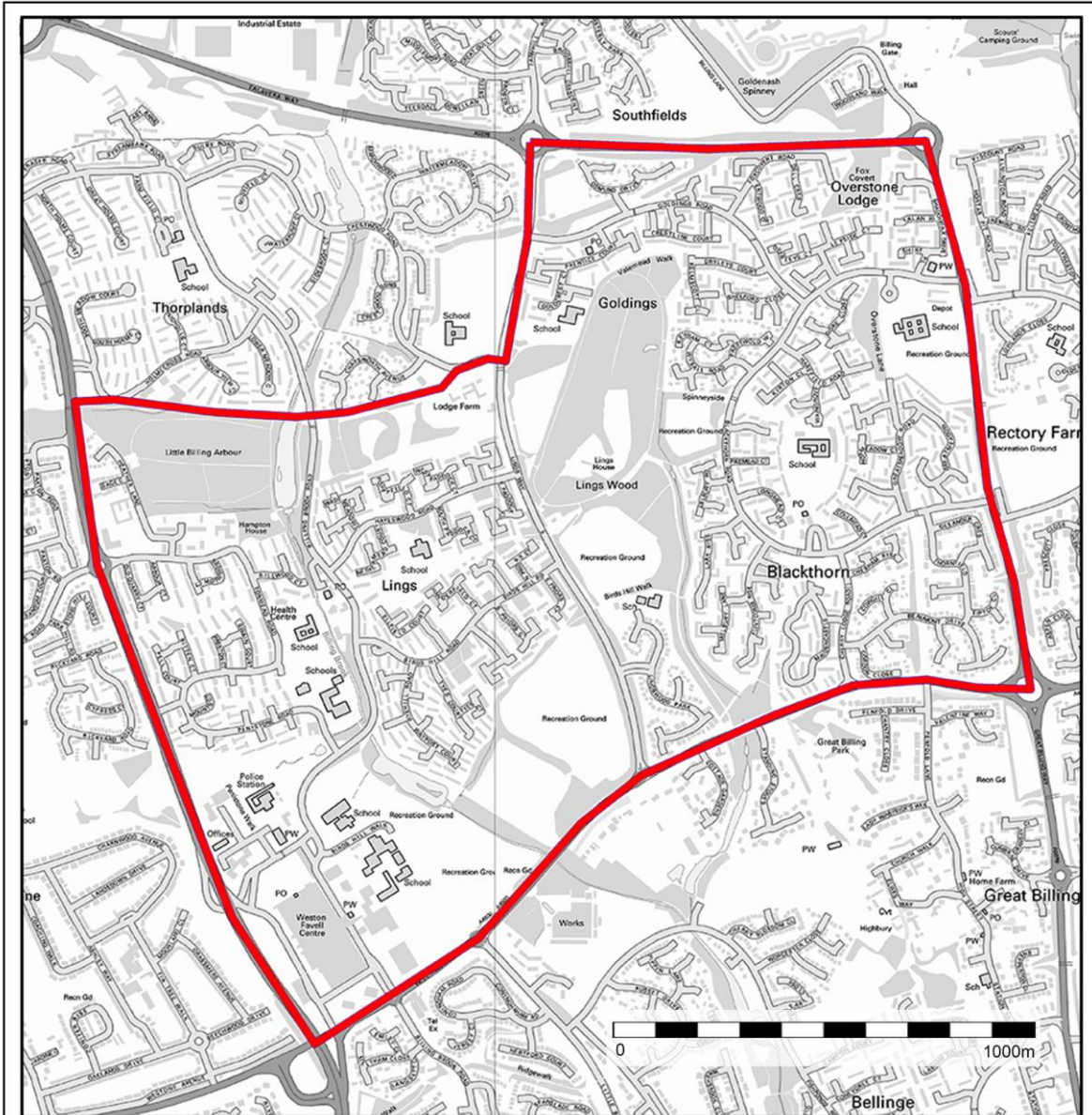
