What is this information about?

Northampton Borough Council has received an application from *Spring Boroughs Voice*, requesting formal designation as a Neighbourhood Forum for the purposes of preparing a Neighbourhood Plan. Comments relating to the proposed Neighbourhood Forum should focus on the appropriateness of the group to prepare a Neighbourhood Plan. If designated, no other organisation or body may prepare a Neighbourhood Plan for the area.

Comments relating to the proposed Neighbourhood Area should consider whether this is a suitable boundary for the Neighbourhood Plan. There may be, for example, buildings or streets that should be included or excluded from the Neighbourhood Area.

In responding to the Area or Forum, you are encouraged to provide reasons. This will help the Borough Council in reaching a decision.

What happens to my comments?

Any comments received will be fully considered by the responsible planning officer. The proposal will be judged against the relevant Council policies and Government advice before a recommendation is made to Northampton Borough Council's cabinet.

A detailed summary of all comments received and any resulting changes required will be reported to the Council's Cabinet before decisions are made.

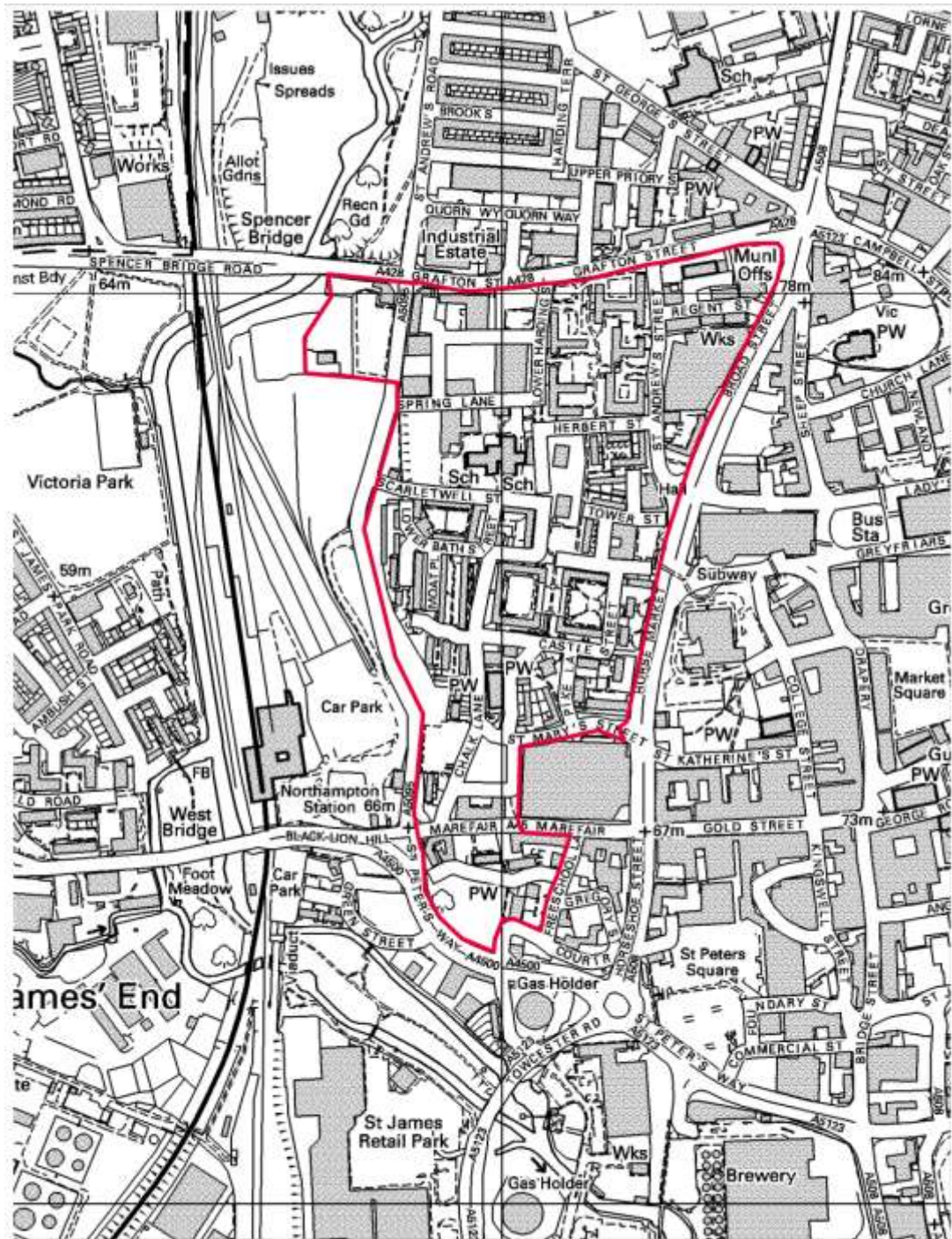
